I am a member in good standing of a Church (not in communion with the Church of England) which subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity and also declare myself to be a member of the Church of England and I have habitually attended public worship in this parish during the period of six months prior to enrolment.

When completed this form should be returned to your parish Electoral Roll Officer.

### Notes

1. Those who become 16 during the next 12 months may complete the form, and become eligible to be entered on the roll on their sixteenth birthday. You must be over the age of 16 on the date of the AGM (and therefore be recorded on the roll) to be eligible to vote.
- 2A. The only Churches at present in communion with the Church of England are other Anglican Churches in Britain and abroad, and certain other foreign Churches.
- 2B. If you do not live within the boundaries of this parish you must have habitually attended public worship at this church for the last six months before you can be entered on the Electoral Roll (see below for exceptions to this rule).
- 2C. Membership of the electoral roll is also open to members in good standing of a Church not in communion with the Church of England **which subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity** where those members are also prepared to declare themselves to be members of the Church of England. Such denominations would include the Methodist, Baptist, Roman Catholic and URC churches.

### Questions & Queries

*My name is already on the Roll – do I need to fill in a form?*

No. If your name is already on the Roll, you do not need to fill in another form this year. However, if any of your details as shown on the current Roll have changed, please provide the Electoral Roll Officer with the corrected details for inclusion in the revised Roll.

*Can I be on the Roll if I am unable actually to attend services at this church week by week?*

If you are a member of the Church of England and resident in the parish you may apply for membership.

If you are not resident in the parish but have previously been on the Roll as a habitual worshipper and have been prevented by sickness or absence or other essential reason from worshipping for the past six months, you may write 'would' before 'have habitually attended' on the form and add 'but was prevented from doing so because .....' and then state the reason.

*I'm still not sure whether I am eligible to (re)apply for membership of the Electoral Roll.*
